## LIXIL Shifts to an Operating Company Structure through Merger with Subsidiary

**Tokyo** – LIXIL Corporation ("LIXIL", TSE Code: 5938), maker of pioneering water and housing products, announced today the completion of the merger between LIXIL Group Corporation, the holding company, and LIXIL Corporation, a wholly owned subsidiary, transitioning to an operating company structure. The former LIXIL Group Corporation serves as the surviving legal entity but has changed its name to LIXIL Corporation to reflect its simplified operating company structure.

LIXIL has implemented a series of transformation measures designed to meet its strategic goal of becoming an entrepreneurial company that can achieve sustainable growth by contributing to society. The transition from a traditional holding company structure to an operating company structure enables faster decision-making and more efficient business operations. Eliminating the two-tiered structure of a holding company and an operating company will also simplify its management structure, increase the transparency of decision-making, and strengthen governance.

LIXIL CEO Kinya Seto said, "We are pleased to complete the merger and transition to an operating company, which will ensure faster decision-making and enhance overall management efficiency. It is another important step to make LIXIL a more agile and entrepreneurial company, and at the same time improves group governance by simplifying and increasing the transparency of management. Under the new structure, we will further focus on actively managing our core businesses in order to accelerate growth, making better homes a reality for everyone, everywhere."
